

# Kansas Board of Regents

## (class of 2012-2014)

All high school graduates and anyone under the age of 21 must meet **one of the following criteria** to be admitted to any one of the six Kansas Regents Universities (Emporia State University, Fort Hays State University, Kansas State University, Pittsburg State University, University of Kansas, and Wichita State University):

- an ACT score of at least 21,
- rank in the top third in their high school graduating class,
- or a grade point average of at least a “C” (2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale) in Qualified Admissions Curriculum (see below)

### Qualified Admissions Curriculum

#### English

- English 1
- English 2
- English 3
- English 4 / English 4 College Prep

**Natural Science** Required to complete **3 units** from the following list with one being Chemistry or Physics:

- Integrated Science or Earth/Space Science
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Advanced Biology
- College Biology
- Physics

**Mathematics** Required to complete **3 units** from the following list:

- Algebra 1 (must be taken at the high school level)
- Algebra 2
- Geometry
- College Algebra
- Calculus

#### Social Sciences

- ½ unit of World History
- 1 unit of U.S. History
- ½ unit of U.S. Government
- 1 additional unit of Social Science credit

#### Foreign Language

Foreign Language is NOT required; however, 2 units of **one** foreign language is recommended for Qualified Admissions
