

# Kansas Board of Regents (class of 2015)

All high school graduates and anyone under the age of 21 must meet ***all of the following criteria*** to be admitted to any one of the six Kansas Regents Universities (Emporia State University, Fort Hays State University, Kansas State University, Pittsburg State University, University of Kansas, and Wichita State University):

- an ACT score of at least 21, or graduate in the top third of your class
- a grade point average of at least a “C” (2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale) in the Qualified Admissions Curriculum (see below)
- and earn a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school

## Qualified Admissions Curriculum (class of 2015)

**English** – 4 units, one unit taken each year of high school, ½ may be speech  
**Natural Science** Required to complete **3 units** from the following list with one being Chemistry or Physics:

- Earth/Space Science
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Advanced Biology
- College Biology
- Physics

**Mathematics** – starting with class of 2015 there are 2 options:

Required to complete **3 units** from the following list and score a 22 on the math portion of the ACT:

- Algebra 1 (must be taken at the high school level)
- Geometry
- Algebra 2
- College Algebra
- Calculus

**Or**

Complete **4 units** with 1 unit taken in the graduating year.

### **Social Sciences**

- ½ unit of World History
- 1 unit of U.S. History
- ½ unit of U.S. Government
- 1 additional unit of Social Science credit

### **Electives**

3 approved units from the following

- English
- Math
- Natural Science
- Social Science
- Fine Arts
- Computer/Information Systems
- Foreign Languages
- Speech / Debate
- Journalism
