PMS Basketball Rules

Grades

1. Schoolwork comes first. You may stay after school to do lessons, and you may be late to practice if:

- You dress first, then report to the teacher
- You get a note from the teacher dated, timed, and signed.
- You attend practice.

2. Second nine weeks ends during BB season. Anyone receiving an F on his grade card will be dropped from the squad.

3. If you have trouble with assignments, ask your teacher for help.

4. Paola athletes should neither be late to school nor miss school. We do not miss school the day after a game. There will be consequences.

Hair

A player's hair must be cut two finger widths above his eyebrows and be neatly trimmed for these reasons:

- So that it will not block his vision.
- So that perspiration will not drip into his eyes.
- Because he represents our school and our community.

As a member of our team, your hair and general appearance must be acceptable.

Practice & Attendance

1. Be at every practice.

2. Dressed, on the floor, and ready to practice.

3. Basketball during practice. When coach is talking-- ears open, mouth shut. Practice should be hard work and FUN.

4. When your group is not practicing, homework in the hall behind the gym. No roaming school halls. You may get help from a teacher if you have gotten permission from both the teacher and your coach. You may work on BB skills on the sidelines if homework finished.

5. All athletes should be gone by 6:00. Have your ride here by then.

6. Parents are welcome at practice. Others will be asked to leave.

7. Unexcused absence-- when you attend school but fail to inform a coach as to why you miss practice. First unexcused, you miss next game. Two unexcused= dismissal from team. Friday school is considered unexcused.

8. Excused-- when you are excused from school, or coaches receive written note from your parents as to your absence.

9. You are responsible for your actions at all times. If you are late to practice for disciplinary reasons twice in one week, you miss the next game. You must attend practice that day. Three times per season= dismissal.

10. Team members ride the bus to and from games. If you must ride home with your parents, they must sign you out with the coaches after the game. You may only ride with your own parents.

11. Parents-- please allow players to play, coaches to coach, and officials to officiate. We should all model sportsmanship as well as desire to our kids.

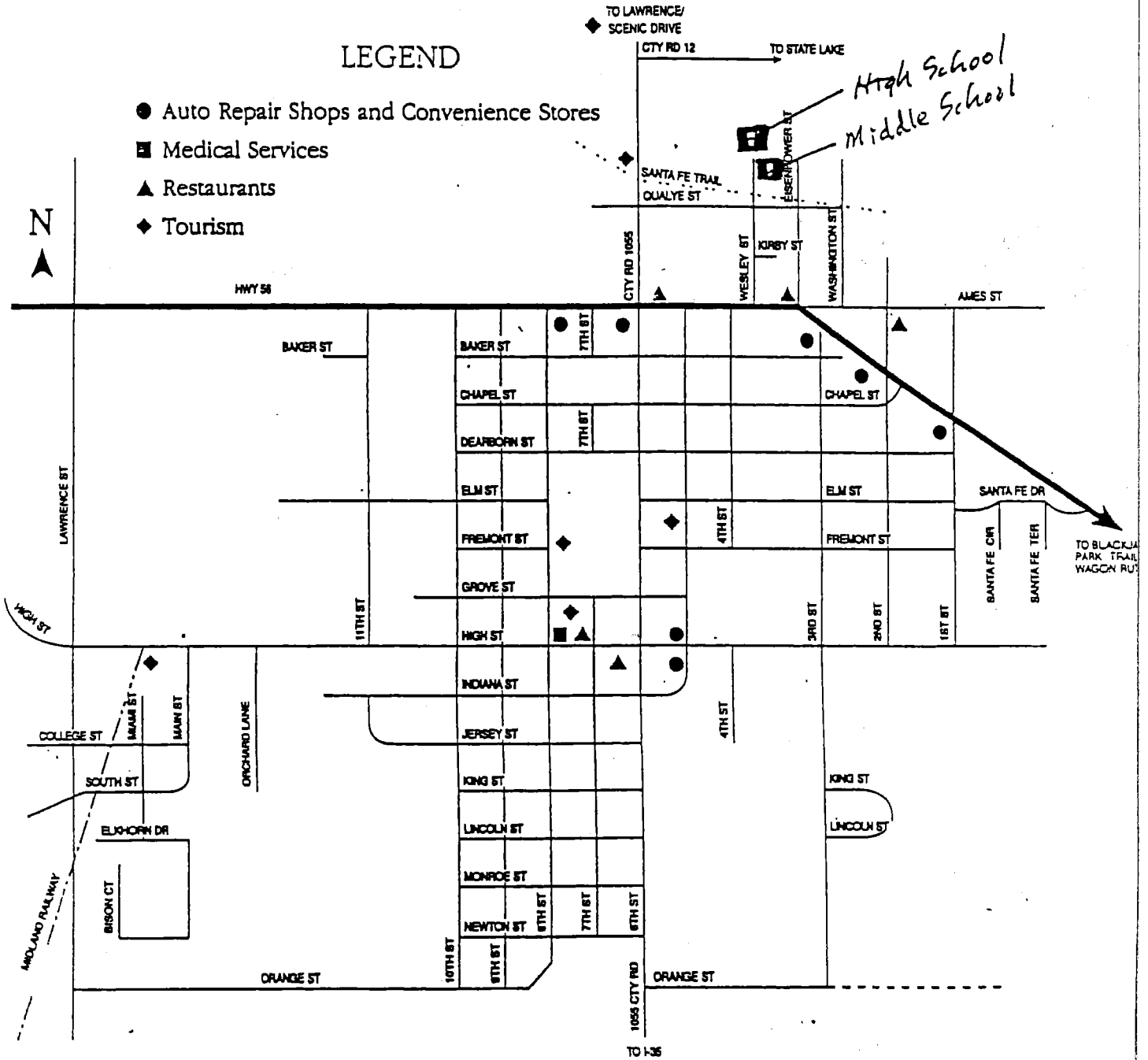

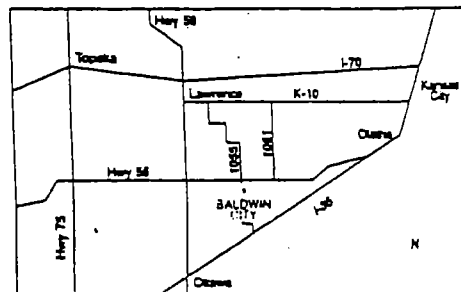
Directions to surrounding cities

To Ottawa: Hwy 56 west to Hwy 59, drive south

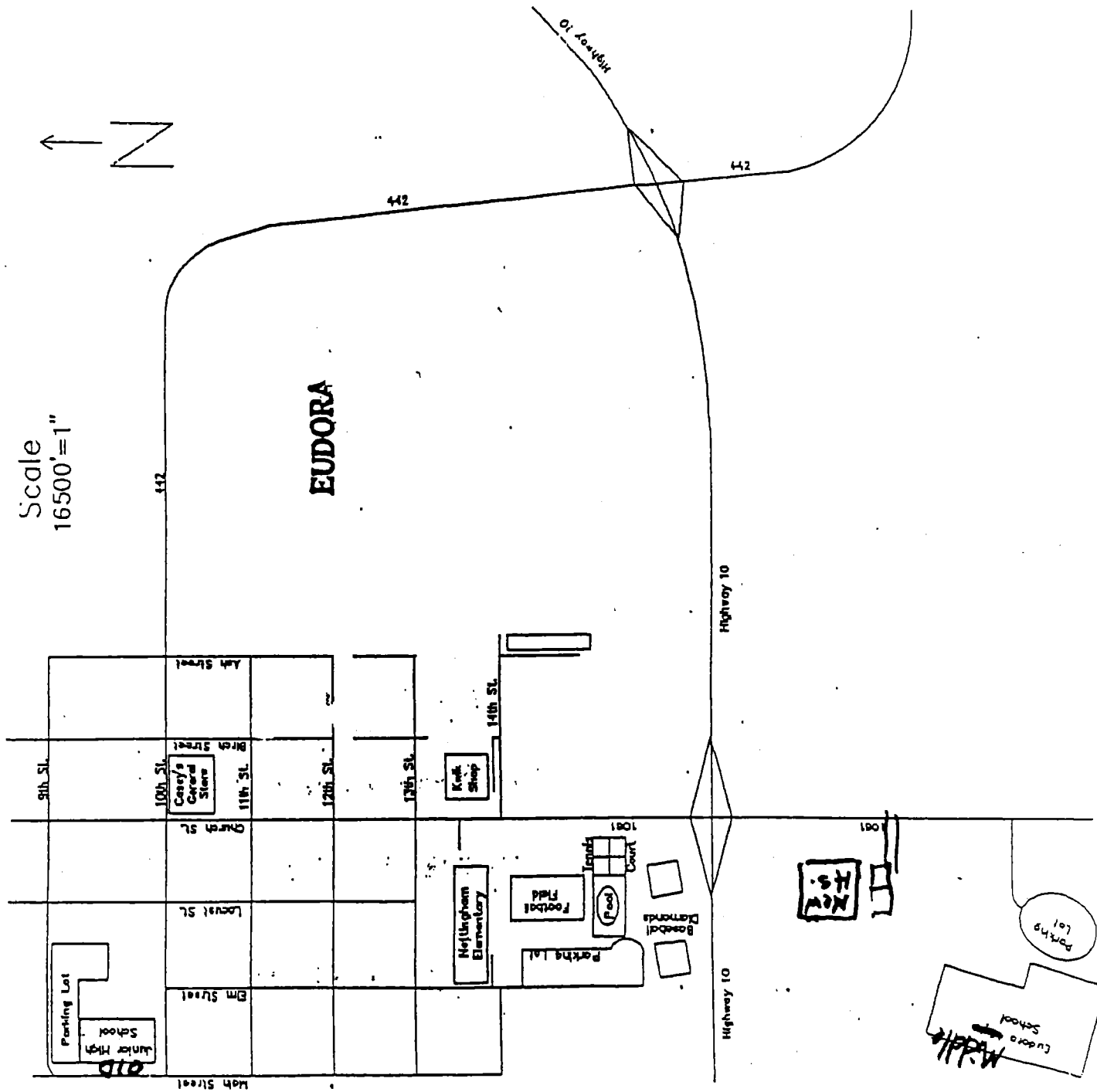
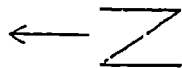


Directions to Monticello Trails

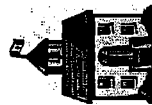

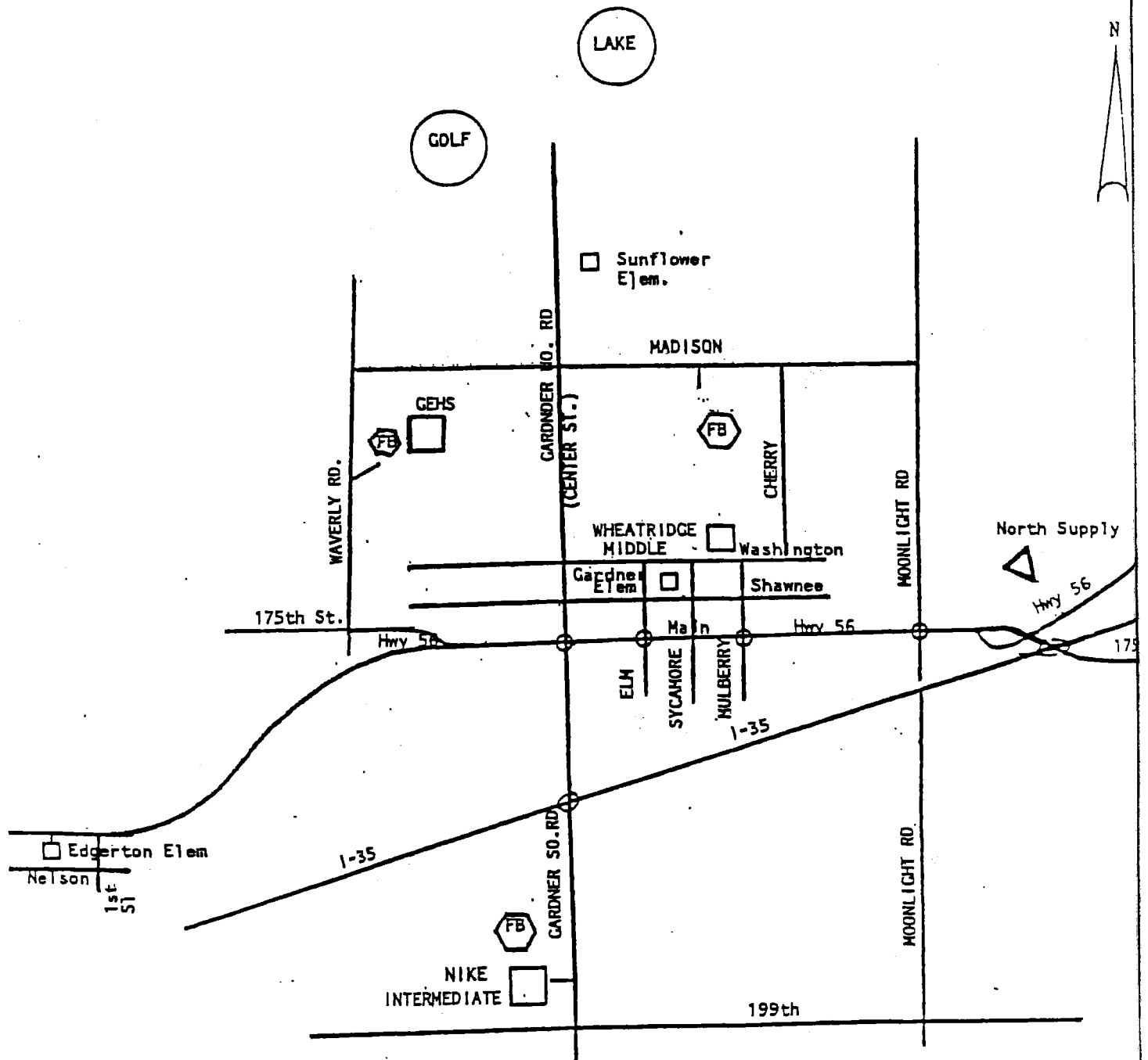

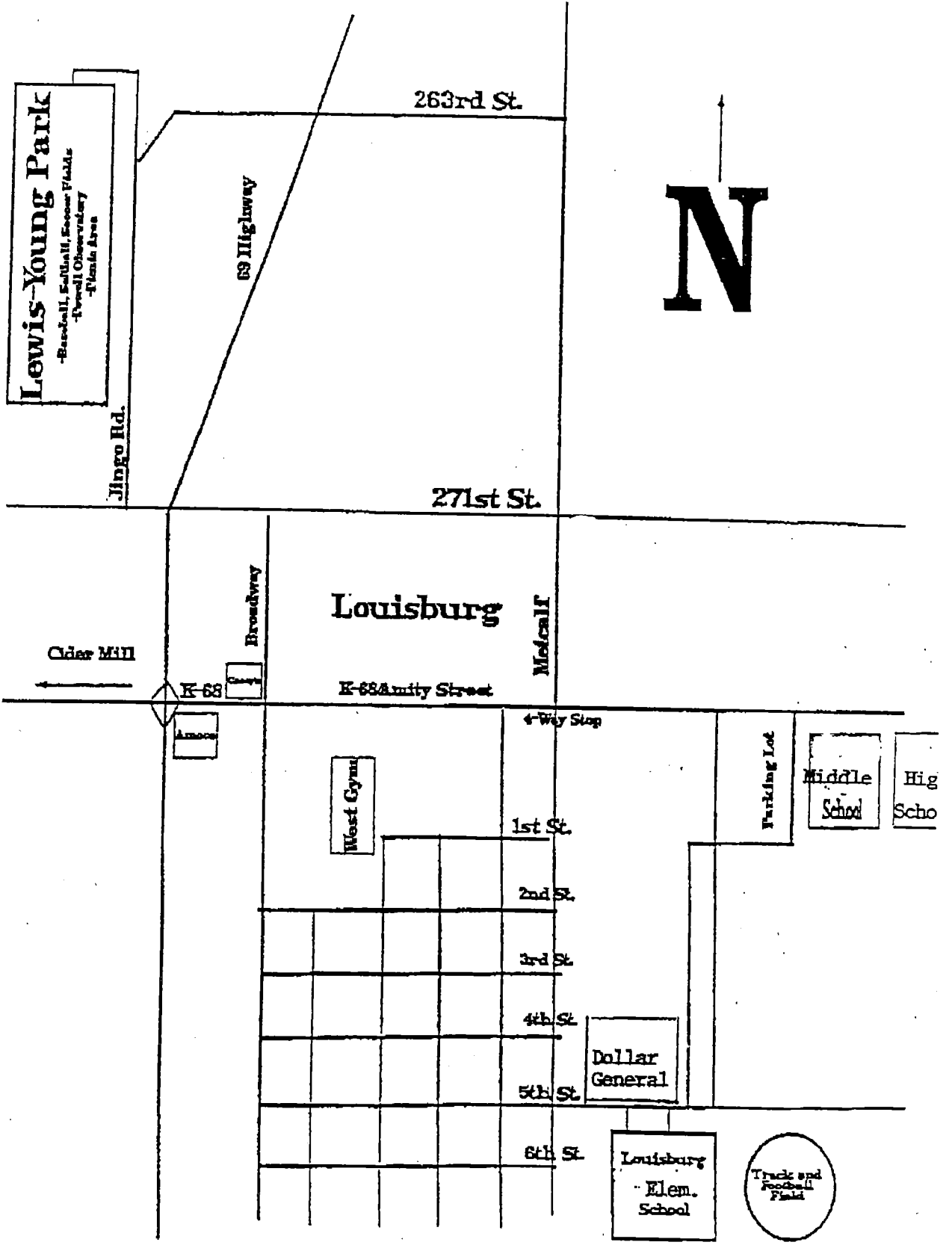

Ottawa Middle School is located at 1230 S. Ash. **From I-35**, exit at the 15th street exit and travel west to Ash Street. Go north on Ash to 13th street. OMS is on the corner and parking is on the west side of the school along 13th street. **From the south**, take 59 hwy. to 15th street, go west to Ash, and north to 13th. **From the north**, take 59 hwy. south to 7th street and turn west. Go west on 7th street to Ash and turn south. Follow Ash to 13th street- the school is on the right at the corner of 13th and Ash.
