Mrs. Welter thanked everyone who worked at the Centralized Enrollment on August 3rd. The day went smoothly and lines were kept to a minimum. She thanked Karen Benton of Kansas Bus Company for her hard work with transportation and she thanked the Paola administrators for the outstanding Board of Education Retreat held earlier this month at Mike Hursey's Casa Somerset.

CURRICULUM PRESENTATION

Assistant Superintendent Matt Meek presented information on how the Paola district fared on Annual Yearly Progress (AYP) for the 2010-2011 school year. He reported all schools made AYP in Reading, Math, and Science and the district made AYP in all but Reading. Special Education scores were lower which brought the district scores down. Mrs. Welter stated this was an opportunity to

make improvements at this level. Mr. Meek noted the State of Kansas did not make AYP in any of the three (3) subjects.

INFORMATION ITEMS

Mrs. Welter updated the board members on the recent school enrollment. The 7 am-7 pm Central Enrollment went exceptionally smooth, with positive comments from parents. The staff worked the long day with positive, supportive attitudes and did an exceptional job of keeping the lines moving all day. President Yocam reminded the Board of Education members of the upcoming Board Retreat on August 30th at 6:00pm with Dr. Doug Moeckel for the purpose of establishing Board of Education goals. Mrs. Welter reported a new radio station in town, KWJP, requested to broadcast various high school and middle school sports and activities.

Mrs. Bledsoe moved to approve allowing KWJP radio station to broadcast PHS and PMS sports and activities. Ms. Franke seconded the motion. Motion carried 6-0.
