Level: 10-12
Credit: 1 unit

Prerequisites: Application, permission of instructor, and have taken or are concurrently enrolled in two of the following: InDesign, PhotoShop, Multimedia or Web Design.

The newspaper journalism course is designed to teach journalistic writing, photography, video and design. In the classroom, students will explore the history of the press, the role of the press in a democratic society, and the legal and ethical issues. In the newsroom, students will brainstorm, research, write, and edit a variety of stories for publication in the *Reporter*, the student newspaper and the publications website. They also will learn the basics of advertising by selling and designing advertisements of community businesses. Students will have their work critiqued by the Kansas Scholastic Press Association and the National Scholastic Press Association.

Level: 10-12
Credit: 1 unit

Prerequisites: Application, permission of instructor, and have taken or are concurrently enrolled in two of the following: InDesign, PhotoShop, Multimedia or Web Design.

The yearbook journalism course is designed to teach journalistic writing, photography and design to publish the Paola High School yearbook, the *Panther* and the publications website. Students will be expected to carry out basic business operations such as selling advertisements and meeting deadlines. Students also will write, edit, and rewrite stories. The Kansas Scholastic Press Association and the National Scholastic Press Association will critique students' work.
