

FOREIGN LANGUAGE

Students whose native language is Spanish may not enroll in Spanish classes.
Students whose native language is French may not enroll in French classes.

PHFL201 French 1

Level: 9-12
Credit: 1 unit

This course, using a communicative approach, is designed to develop speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills in French. Basic geography and customs and cultures of the francophone world will be presented. The text, video, and CDs will be used as examples of grammatical usage and pronunciation in order to improve listening and reading comprehension.

PHFS202 French 2 **Prerequisite: French 1**

Level: 10-12
Credit: 1 unit

The second year, with an emphasis on communication, will further the development of grammatical structures, reading and listening comprehension, and oral fluency in French. The text, video, and CDs will be used as examples of grammatical usage and to improve reading and listening comprehension. Pronunciation and oral proficiency will be stressed.

PHFS203 French 3 **Prerequisite: French 2**

Level: 11-12
Credit: 1 unit

The third year, with an emphasis on communication, will further the development of grammatical structures, reading, and listening comprehension, and oral fluency in French. Students will also focus on developing understanding of the history and culture of Francophone countries. The text, video, and CDs will be used as examples of grammatical usage and to improve reading, listening and cultural comprehension. Pronunciation and oral proficiency will be stressed.

PHFL101 Spanish 1

Level: 9-12
Credit: 1 unit

The aims of the first year Spanish program will include the following: developing oral competence of the words and phrases included in the text, developing reading skills, studying the grammar used in oral and written recitation, and developing a cultural awareness of the countries that use the language. The text and CD's will be used to indicate examples of grammatical usage and to improve reading and listening comprehension.

PHFL102 Spanish 2 **Prerequisite: Spanish 1**

Level: 10-12
Credit: 1 unit

The second year will be used for the further development of grammatical structures, reading and listening comprehension, and oral fluency. The text and CD's will be used to indicate examples of grammatical usage and to improve reading and listening comprehension.
