

Kansas Board of Regents

All high school graduates and anyone under the age of 21 must meet ***all of the following criteria*** to be admitted to five of the six Kansas Regents Universities (Emporia State University, Fort Hays State University, Kansas State University, Pittsburg State University, and Wichita State University):

- an ACT score of at least 21, or graduate in the top third of your class
- a grade point average of at least a “C” in the Qualified Admissions Curriculum
- and earn a 2.0 GPA or higher on any college credit taken in high school

***Beginning with the class of 2016, KU has increased admissions criteria. Please see their website for more information.**

Qualified Admissions Curriculum

English – 4 units, one unit taken each year of high school, ½ may be speech

Natural Science Required to complete **3 units** from the following list with one being Chemistry or Physics:

- Earth/Space Science
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Advanced Biology
- College Biology
- Physics

Mathematics – satisfied by completing 1 of the following **2 options**:

Required to complete **3 units** from the following list and score a 22 on the math portion of the ACT:

- Algebra 1 (must be taken at the high school level)
- Geometry
- Algebra 2
- Trigonometry/Algebra 3
- College Algebra
- AP Calculus

Or

Complete **4 units** with 1 unit taken in the graduating year.

Social Sciences – 3 units including

- 1 unit of World History
- 1 unit of U.S. History
- ½ unit of U.S. Government
- ½ unit of Social Science elective credit
